




Imprecation Definition: "A Spoken Curse"

Imprecatory Psalms or Prayers





They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Revelation 6:10

Fill their faces with shame, that they may seek your name, O LORD. Let them be put to shame and dismayed forever; let them perish in disgrace, that they may know that you alone, whose name is the LORD, are the Most High over all the earth.

Praying To The Lord For His Incomparable Deliverance

1) An Imprecatory Prayer That Pleads For Deliverance (Psalm 35)

- a) "Fight For Me!" Warfare Language (v1-10)
- b) "Rescue Me!" Legal Language (v11-18)
- c) "Vindicate Me!" Cleansing Language (v19-28)
