# (1) Like Nebuchadnezzar, Without Repentance, We Are Destined To Act Like Beasts






### Nebuchadnezzar's Signs Of Pride

- 1) Belief that we are the source, and life is for our glory
- 2) Find ourselves driven from God's kingdom
- 3) Driven by selfishness, not selflessness
- 4) Heart hardened to repentance

- 2) Harming rather than serving Gal 5:13-15
- 3) Refuse godly counsel 2 Tim. 4:3-4
- 4) Listen to the world over the church 1 John 4:5-6
- 5) Hardness of heart that refuses covenant commitment Eph. 4:17-24
- 6) We return to sin from which we have repented -
- 2 Pet. 2:20-22
