

The Ultimate Miracle: The Exodus God Incarnate


Mark 6:45-56

(2) The Core Understanding Of The Exodus God Is That He Saves His People

Look down from heaven and see, from your holy and beautiful habitation.

Where are your zeal and your might?

The stirring of your inner parts and your compassion are held back from me.

For you are our Father,

though Abraham does not know us,

and Israel does not acknowledge us;

you, O Lord, are our Father,

our Redeemer from of old is your name.

O LORD, why do you make us wander from your ways and harden our heart, so that we fear you not?

Return for the sake of your servants, the tribes of your heritage.
Your holy people held possession for a little while; our adversaries have trampled down your sanctuary.
We have become like those over whom you have never ruled, like those who are not called by your name.
Oh that you would rend the heavens and come down,

that the mountains might quake at your presence...

Isaiah 63:15-64:1




Figure 1: A picture of biblical cosmology (Reyburn and Fry 1998:27).

Then the LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters. I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a good and broad land, a land flowing with milk and honey...

Exodus 3:7-8

God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you.'" God also said to Moses, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations.
